Heritage Project

Over the festive period, the Heritage Team have been hard at work sorting through the memorabilia that has been collected through the project. Based over in the East Stand, hundreds of programmes, tickets, posters and other artefacts are being catalogued and prepared for future Heritage displays. At the most recent meeting, the committee itemised and logged every item in the WAFC trophy cabinet. The ultimate aim of this is to set up a small Heritage Museum room that fans can visit to be immersed the history of our club.

The group have also offered Heritage Stadium Tours in January, with all proceeds going back into the Heritage Project development. These funds have been used to purchase a professional book and document scanner so that items can be preserved electronically as well as physically. More tour dates will be announced soon!
